Professor Michael Avidan

Professor Michael Avidan is the Dr Seymour and Rose T. Brown Professor of Anesthesiology at Washington University in St. Louis. He is also the Director of the Institute of Quality Improvement, Research and Informatics, and is the Division Chief of Cardiothoracic Anesthesiology.



Associate Professor Marjorie Stiegler

Dr Marjorie Stiegler is an Associate Professor of Anesthesiology at the University of North Carolina and the Director of the Consortium for Anesthesiology Patient Safety and Experiential Learning. She serves on several national committees for patient safety, quality improvement and professional liability. She is also an examiner for the American Board of Anesthesiology and an elected member of the Academy of University Anesthesiologists.



Dr Philipp Lirk

Dr Philipp Lirk studied Medicine in Innsbruck, Austria, before undertaking a research fellowship at the Medical College of Wisconsin. After completing his postgraduate degree, he moved to The Netherlands, where he is now an Attending Anesthesiologist at the Academic Medical Center, University of Amsterdam. He heads the Regional Anesthesia service and is in charge of two international academic exchange programs.

Professor David Story is the Foundation Chair of Anaesthesia at the University of Melbourne and Head of the Anaesthesia, Perioperative and Pain Medicine Unit. 
